Yet, many of them still have tears.

THRIVE is an event designed for women to gather together to help wipe the tears of our sisters around the world. The women's team of Advancing Native Missions put together this two day conference to encourage women from all walks of life to THRIVE in the presence of the King.

By hosting or attending a THRIVE conference your women will be taken on a journey.

- They will *connect* with other women as they listen to the amazing SHE stories told by visiting native missionaries.
- They will *engage* by having the opportunity to offer themselves as a vessel for His glory.

Hosting Benefits. There are many benefits to hosting a THRIVE conference. Your women will:

- become excited about what God is doing around the world
- be engaged in prayer
- be challenged from the presence of a native missionary in your town
- carry the excitement of the weekend back into their homes and your church

Hosting Costs. The cost of having an ANM women's team come participate is free; however, we would appreciate if you would help us promote the conference love offering. Half of the funds raised from the conference love offering will be given to Advancing Native Missions to help native missionaries share the Gospel with unreached around the world. And, in an effort to partner with you, ANM would like to offer to share the funds raised at the conference to help your missions department engage in sponsoring native missionaries, sending teams overseas, and to help your missions program. *In addition to the conference love offering, an honorarium would be greatly appreciated to cover the travel costs of the ANM team.*

Advancing Native Missions (ANM) is responsible to:

- Provide women ANM staff and native missionaries as speakers for your conference.
- Provides introductory and engagement videos.
- Send a promotional packet for the host church to use to engage their community.
- Provide opportunities for church or individuals to sponsor ANM missionary/child.
- Provide regional prayer sheets for church to pass out to congregation.
- Present a selection of children's missions curriculum, books, bags, jewelry, and CDs for individuals and churches to purchase at all events. *(All profits will go to support native missions efforts through ANM.)*
- ANM may be able to provide a band or worship leader if the church is not able. *(upon request)*
- ANM will supply registration packets

Host church is responsible to:

- Promote event within the local church using the suggestions in the promotional packet.
- Designate a leadership team responsible for the following: Dessert and coffee time and meals for conference if applicable, onsite resource sales for ANM tables, publicity within the churches, and promotion outside the church, refreshments and hospitality, interaction with the ANM representatives.
- Provide volunteers for greeting, refreshments, and resource table.
- Provide audio-visual capabilities for PA, piano, microphones, DVD, and PowerPoint presentation.
- Provide an auditorium and classroom space for general sessions and break-out sessions.
- Provide host homes for ANM team.
- *Collect love offering funds made out to Advancing Native Missions.*
- *Church provides names through holding pre-registration so ANM can furnish packets for attendees at no cost to the church.*
