### GIFTS IN KIND

Gifts in kind are the donations you make of materials requested by our native ministry partners. ANM locates, collects, and ships these materials overseas in containers and smaller shipments that richly bless our ministry partners throughout the world. These critical materials meet essential needs. They include medicines, hygiene products, office and school supplies, furniture, and other items key to ministry operations and outreach. In the last two years, our shipments have increasingly been used to bless refugees from Iraq and Syria as a testament to God's love for them. Gifts in kind donations continue to be recorded in strict compliance with IRS regulations and ECFA standards. All glory to God!

### ANM OPERATING EXPENSES

ANM operates on the smallest possible budget. Our goal is to send the most funds possible to our international ministry partners. As good stewards of God's calling, we routinely examine every expense in relation to our mission. This year, despite record cash revenues, we were able to slightly cut our operating expense. Most of ANM's staff live sacrificially so our goals can be achieved, and we also rely on the faithfulness of volunteers.

One of the best ways to gauge the efficiency of any charitable organization is the "Expense Ratio." This is the measurement of total operating expenses relative to total donations: the lower the ratio, the greater the percentage of each donation that is actually benefiting those who are served. ANM's expense ratio of 11.7% means that 88.3% of each dollar donated to ANM directly benefits our native missionary partners. This is a level of efficiency that continues to earn ANM the highest ratings from the top non-profit watchdog groups. All glory to God!

## our calling

“The Gospel of the Kingdom shall be preached in all the world as a witness to all nations and then the end shall come.” – Matthew 24:14

What a challenge! There are over 7 billion people in the world today, of which about 3 billion remain unreached with the Gospel. This means that 40% of the earth's population has not heard about Jesus. Yet God has provided a solution for this challenge: native missionaries, called by God to share the Gospel with their own people.

Native missionaries frequently work in poor and underdeveloped areas of the world. Often they labor without financial support and in the face of intense persecution. Thus, they usually lack adequate resources for their ministries and workers. Despite these hurdles, they are very fruitful and effective because they know the languages, cultures, and ways of the natives...because they are the natives.

## a bridge

ANM is a bridge between hundreds of local churches and thousands of individuals in the US and over 250 native missionary organizations operating in over 80 countries. These organizations represent over 5,000 individual native missionaries working among thousands of different people groups.

We foster relationships between individuals, organizations, and churches in the West and native missionary organizations in the field. We choose native missionary partners according to strict standards of doctrinal integrity, financial accountability, fruitfulness, and the strategic orientation of their ministry towards reaching the unreached.

## three goals

1. Equip them with the funds and resources they need.
2. Encourage them in an ongoing way as they labor.
3. Advocate on their behalf, increasing their circle of friends and partners.

As we accomplish these goals, we also pray that the western church will be challenged with a broader vision of all that God is doing to reach the unreached before Christ's return.

## get involved.

**LEARN.** ANM offers various media resources for teaching individuals and churches how God is working through native missionaries around the world.

**CONNECT.** Connect personally with native missionaries by hosting them in your home, inviting them to speak to your church or small group, attending an ANM event, or even bringing an ANM missions conference to your church.

**ENGAGE.** ANM seeks to help US Christians become more fully engaged with missions work through opportunities to pray, give, and go. We want to help you take the next step.

## Program Goals

ANM seeks out, evaluates, and supports native missions organizations that have a clear evangelical statement of faith, are open and transparent in their finances, and seek to primarily work among unreached people groups in their region. We intentionally seek to increase financial support to those organizations we choose to partner with and thereby increase the number of unreached people groups they are collectively engaging.

## Program Results

According to Joshua Project, there are 16,510 people groups in the world. Of this total, 6,672 are defined as unreached, where there is no community of believers who have the resources to propagate the Gospel. As of the end of 2015, ANM's partner native missionary organizations are engaging 465 unreached people groups. It is our mission at ANM to fully participate in God's plan for world evangelization until our vision in Matthew 24:14 is fulfilled.
