DAY 1

Pray for people who are nominal Christians

While many people in our communities identify as Christian, they often don't have a personal faith like we do. They may go to church for holidays or claim a Christian identity because of infant baptism, but don't have a relationship with God. If these people begin to seek God more intimately, we will start to see revival in our communities.

Pray for:

- An open mind, that people who are nominally Christian will hear and receive the Gospel in a fresh way.
- A change of heart, that people who have thought of themselves as Christians all their life will pursue a genuine, deep relationship with Jesus.



DAY 2

Pray for people who are drifting away from their faith

Disagreements over social issues, disillusionment about church scandals, and everyday concerns can cause Christians to drift away from their faith. These influences stand in the way of genuine revival.

Pray for:

- Unity, that Christians will work together to overcome disagreements and scandals and encourage one another towards revival.
- Steadfastness, that Christians who are struggling in their faith because of disagreements, scandals, or other problems will persevere and continue to believe.



DAY 3

Pray for Christians and churches in your community

If we want to see God change our communities for the better, we must work together to reach others. The best way to do this is through the local church. As we cooperate in prayer, outreach, and other ways, we can see revival start to take place.

Pray for:

- Local churches in your area, that they will have the resources for evangelism, discipleship, and missions.
- Boldness, so that Christians like yourself can confidently share your faith with others who are nominal Christians or people who have never considered the Christian faith.



DAY 4

Pray for immigrants and refugees in your community

Our communities are rapidly changing as the areas we live in accept immigrants and refugees. Many of these immigrants and refugees have different religious and cultural beliefs from us. As we show them God's love, they can join the revivals we're praying for.

Pray for:

- Hospitality, that Christians and churches in your community will welcome new people and show them the love of Christ in practical ways.
- Courage for the Christians and churches who are reaching out, that they will share the Gospel with these new people.



DAY 5

Pray for native missionaries throughout Europe

Native missionaries, who are believing Christians serving in their local or nearby areas, live and work across Europe. They are helping individuals and churches, including immigrant and refugee populations, and sharing Jesus's love through words and deeds. (Meet two of these native European missionaries on page 9.)

Pray for:

- Resources for these native missionaries, so they will have the financial means and practical supplies to do God's work.
- Good physical, mental, emotional, and spiritual health, so they can continue to serve in communities like yours.



DAY 6

Pray for revival and evangelistic events

Opwekking is just the start of revival and evangelistic events taking place throughout Europe this year. You may be planning to attend other revival events. Consider how you can get involved through prayer, volunteering, or inviting others.

Pray for:

- Attendance, that the people God calls to attend revival and evangelistic events will go with open minds and hearts.
- Effectiveness, that God will use the speakers at the events to share the messages people need to hear so they can grow in their faith or accept Jesus as their Savior.



DAY 7

Pray for yourself

As we come to the end of this prayer week, take time to pray for yourself. If you are facing any personal challenges, trying to discern how to get involved with a local ministry, or simply need time to reflect on all God has done for you, take time to do so. Dedicating prayer and quiet time to your walk with God is the only way you will grow in faith, which is the first step of revival.

Pray that:

- You will follow God's lead in all areas of your life, whether you're enduring a difficult time or enjoying a happy time.
- You will have an increase in faith, allowing you to walk closer with God and share the Gospel more with others.

Meet Hari and Penka in Bulgaria

Hari and Penka are professional artists and pastors in the Rhodope mountains, which are in the South-East of Bulgaria. There are few fellow Christians in their community because the population predominantly identifies as Muslim. They pastor a church in the area and provide art lessons to children, using both opportunities to share the Gospel.
