Ways to Pray

EQUIP MISSIONARIES FOR SERVICE

"They prayed and laid their hands on them. So the word of God spread." - Acts 6:6-7

1. A missionary training school in Bali will soon send out 13 graduates. Pray for boldness as these new missionaries begin their work.
2. Many missionaries serve with partial support and work side jobs to provide for their families. Pray for wisdom and provision as they balance responsibilities.
3. A missionary training school in Jakarta has 120 students preparing for ministry. Pray for fruitful studies, strong relationships, and a shared focus on Jesus.



CARE FOR CHILDREN

"Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these." - Luke 18:16

1. One missionary team in Indonesia plans to start five new children's ministry centers in the next year. Pray that children will come to know Christ and become future Christian leaders.
2. Ten ministry centers around Bali serve 350 children with meals, Gospel teaching, and more. Pray for transformation in the hearts of the children and their families.
3. Many missionaries have children. Pray for faithfulness and provision as they go to school, graduate and start jobs, and even have families of their own.

STRENGTHEN THE CHURCH

"In him the whole building is joined together and rises to become a holy temple in the Lord." – Ephesians 2:21

1. Most Indonesians are Muslim and may not even know a Christian. Pray for Indonesian churches to reach out specifically to Muslims, sharing the Gospel in loving and sensitive ways.
2. Christians are a small and sometimes isolated minority in Indonesia. Pray for unity among churches, pastors, and mission organizations working in Indonesia.
3. Many Christians are new believers with a strong passion for God's Kingdom. Pray for good Bible teaching and discipleship so believers can grow deep in their faith.

REACH THE LOST AND UNREACHED

"Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous works among all the peoples!" – 1 Chronicles 16:24

1. One missionary team aims to plant five churches this year. Another has a long-term vision to plant 1,000 churches across the country. Pray for courage and steadfastness among these missionaries.
2. Muslims who become Christians may face opposition from family, friends, neighbors, and coworkers. Pray for protection and courage for believers who endure persecution and hardship for their faith.
3. A mobile medical ministry in Bali serves dozens of patients each month. Pray for provision of medical supplies and for healing as the team treats, prays, and shares the Gospel with those in need.
